CCPS Issues Alert for Potential Inclement Weather

JONESBORO - Clayton County Public Schools' (CCPS) leadership is sharing a report from the National Weather Service indicating that conditions associated with an active weather pattern could provide rainfall today, August 3, and continuing into Friday, August 4, morning. The main impact on our area is expected to occur as the system passes through the area during the evening and into the morning, providing heavy rainfall, possible thunderstorms, and wind gusts.

Families with children are advised to prepare for the potential conditions by dressing them appropriately in rain gear, including umbrellas if available. It is possible that weather conditions may cause delays in transportation.

While the school district will continue to monitor conditions throughout this afternoon and evening, we encourage everyone to be safe and stay connected for updated information regarding any potential weather issues through the following outlets:
