CCPS Schedules Early Dismissal for High and Middle School Students on December 14-15, 2023

JONESBORO - Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) announces that it will institute an early dismissal schedule for high and middle school students taking exams on ***Thursday and Friday, December 14-15, 2023***. High School students will be dismissed at 1:00 p.m., and middle school students will be dismissed at 3:15 (30 minutes earlier than their normal dismissal). All elementary students will be dismissed at their regular scheduled time.

“The decision to implement this early dismissal schedule is aligned with the exam schedule at the high and middle school levels,” said Dr. Anthony W. Smith, CCPS Superintendent/CEO. “The adjusted time is not expected to have a negative effect on dismissal at the elementary level.”

The district will return to a regular dismissal schedule for all levels on ***Wednesday January 3, 2024***, the start of the second semester.
