Within the division of School Choice, the MSAP department strives to provide diverse opportunities that enhance student achievement and enable them to lead fulfilling lives. The initiative aims to encourage students from various economic, ethnic, and racial backgrounds to engage in classroom and extracurricular activities, while also enhancing teachers' teaching skills and promoting students' interest in STEM-related careers.

Magnet School Assistance Program

The Magnet Schools Assistance Program provides grants to eligible local education agencies to establish and operate magnet schools, with special curricula, to attract a diverse group of students and desegregate public schools.

The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP) grant provided to CCPS is transforming four schools - two elementary, one middle, and one high school - from conventional education programs into whole-school magnet programs.


