District Shares Weather Alert - Heat Index Forecast

JONESBORO - Clayton County Public Schools is sharing the following special weather alert as provided by the National Weather Services (NWS).

The NWS has shared information related to heat conditions for this area through Saturday, July 29, 2023. With temperatures hovering in the high 90s and a daily heat index at or above 100 degrees, it is recommended that any outdoor activities be brought inside if feasible or postponed/delayed to later in the evening. Air quality alerts are also being issued for this same time frame.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to take this information into consideration when planning return-to-school activities through the weekend and into the coming week.
