General Primary Election to Impact 42 CCPS Campuses

On Tuesday, May 22, Clayton County registered voters will have the opportunity to cast ballots for a variety of state, regional and local offices as part of the General Primary/Nonpartisan Election. Forty-two (42) of our schools will serve as polling places for this election. (See list below.)

Tuesday, May 22, is also the next to last day of the 2017-18 school year for Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS). CCPS reminds everyone to anticipate a higher than normal level of traffic in and around our schools. This is especially for those schools that serve as polling places.

Traditionally, district leadership operates at a higher level of on campus security as the final days of the school year approaches. This level will be increased as a result of additional traffic in and around polling place schools as generated by the primary election.

CCPS encourages everyone to be patient and to add a few minutes for any travel to and from these schools on May 22. Also be aware that parking may be limited. We ask visitors on our campuses to use appropriate parking and following any instructions issued by a School Resource Officer (SRO) or Campus Security Officer (CSO).
