CCBOE to Hold Two Public Hearings on the Tentative FY2019 Budget

CCPS Superintendent Beasley to Update Community on the FY2019 Budget and its preparations

JONESBORO – Pending approval of the Tentative FY2019 Budget by the Clayton County Board of Education (CCBOE) on May 7, 2018, two public hearings will be held on Monday, May 14, 2018 at 6 p.m. and Monday, May 21, 2018 at 6 p.m. Both meetings will be held at the Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) Administration Complex, 1058 Fifth Avenue in Jonesboro.

Immediately following the public hearing, Dr. Morcease J. Beasley, CCPS Superintendent of Schools, will offer a Community Budget Update. The presentation will include a review of the FY2018 Budget and a preview of the FY2019 Budget, featuring an outline of the process used by district leadership to build it.
