Board of Education Approves Revisions in ESA Calendars

During the September 24, 2018 Clayton County Board of Education (CCBOE) work session, the Board approved a recommendation to revise the 2018-19 and the 2019-20 Academic Calendars for Elite Scholars Academy (ESA). The change in the calendars was requested to facilitate the state's fall FTE (Full-Time Equivalent) student count. The Board's action will result in the following adjustments:

- Monday, October 8, 2018 has been changed from a Non-Instructional Day to an Instructional Day.
- Monday, June 3, 2019 becomes the last day for the 2018-19 school year; post planning for ESA staff becomes June 4-6, 2019. (Students will attend 180 days of instruction.)
- In the 2019-20 Academic Calendar, the Fall Intersession has been adjusted to Monday, September 16, 2019 through Friday, September 27, 2019.
