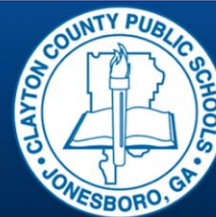

Clayton County BOE Approves Revised 2019-20 Calendar

JONESBORO - During the September 3, 2019, Clayton County Board of Education (CCBOE) meeting, the Board approved a recommendation to revise the 2019-20 Academic Calendar. The action will result in the following adjustments to the District's calendar:

- Monday, March 16, 2020 - Staff Development Day becomes a regular instructional day
- Thursday, May 21, 2020 - Regular instructional day becomes the Last Day of 2019-20 School Year (Students will still attend 180 days of instruction.)
- Friday, May 22 - Previously the Last Day of 2019-20 School Year becomes a Staff Development/Post-Planning Day
- Thursday, May 28, 2020 - Remains the Last Day for 190-day personnel

The Board's approval now makes possible the scheduling of graduation ceremonies for the Class of 2020 to be held Thursday through Saturday, May 21-23, 2020, at the Georgia International Convention Center (GICC) in College Park, Georgia.
