



CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Pre-Kindergarten Registration for 2019-2020 School Year

A child must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2019 to qualify for this program.

Acceptance into Pre-K classes in the public schools will be based on a computer generated “LOTTERY SYSTEM” for each site with priority given to children residing within the individual school attendance areas. Parents may register their child for only one Clayton County Public Schools’ Pre-K site of their choice.

Application Dates and Times:

Pre-registration for the Pre-K Lottery begins during the first week of March.

After pre-registration has ended parents may sign-up for the Pre-K waiting list at individual school sites.

Items Needed to Apply:

Child’s ‘Original-State Issued’ Birth Certificate

Parent’s ‘Government Issued’ Photo ID

Child’s Social Security Card

Two ‘Current’ Proofs of Residency

(mortgage statement, rental agreement, utility bills: gas, water, and electric)
