Board of Education to Conduct Virtual Called Meeting - Monday, July 13

Superintendent to host a Live YouTube message, Tuesday, July 14, at 1:00 p.m.

JONESBORO – The Clayton County Board of Education (CCBOE) will hold a virtual Called Board Meeting Monday, July 13, 2020. The called meeting is scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. Action is expected on the proposed FY2021 Budget, a recommendation to reopen schools using an all virtual option, and a recommendation to move the first day of school back five days to August 10, 2020. An agenda is attached.
