Get Ready for Middle School

Children who were born on or after Jan. 1, 2002, who are attending 7th grade or who are new entrants to a Georgia school in grades 8 through 12 must have received one dose of tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap) vaccine and one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4).

Proof of both vaccinations must be documented on the Georgia Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231), and certified by a licensed Georgia healthcare provider.

The Clayton County Board of Health offers:

- Immunizations (Form 3231)
- Vision, hearing, dental and nutrition screenings (Form 3300)
- Birth certificates for children born in Georgia







Payment for clinical services may be made by cash, debit/credit card or a check from a Georgia bank. Clients with Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids are welcome. Also, Aetna and State Health Benefits Plan (Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Georgia).

- Birth certificates for children born in Georgia are available from Vital Records.
- Payments for birth certificates may be made by cash or debit/credit card only.
