### **2023 Superintendent's Scholarship Golf Tournament a Success** *Funds raised will be distributed during upcoming graduation ceremonies*

**JONESBORO** – On Friday, May 5, thirty-plus teams participated in the 10th Annual Superintendent's Scholarship Golf Tournament at the Lake Spivey Golf Club in Jonesboro. Delta Air Lines, Pro LogicsITS, and Boxlight served as title sponsors for this year's event.

All proceeds from the tournament go to the Clayton County Public Schools Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, to support the CCPS' Student Scholarship Fund which sustains the district's work to promote post-secondary success for CCPS' students by generating scholarships. Last year's tournament raised an estimated \$200,000 in cash and prizes to support this endeavor and more than 220 scholarships and awards were distributed to CCPS' 2022 graduating seniors and outstanding staff. Nearly \$230,000 has been raised to support Class of 2023 scholarships.

The 10th Annual Superintendent's Golf Tournament honored Dr. Anthony W. Smith, CCPS Interim Superintendent of Schools, for his vision and leadership related to the promotion and expansion of the tournament since its inception in 2013.
