JONESBORO - Monday, November 6, 2023, featured an expanded session of the Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) weekly Executive Cabinet. Superintendent/CEO of Schools, Dr. Anthony W. Smith, welcomed current and former superintendents and leadership team members from surrounding school districts for a thought-provoking special presentation. Guests included Mr. Trent North, Superintendent of Douglas County Schools; Dr. Eric Holland, Superintendent of Rome City Schools; and Dr. Aaron Geter, Superintendent of Wilkinson County Schools. Also in attendance were Dr. Curtis Jones, Georgia School Superintendents Association and former Superintendent of Bibb County [and 2019 National Superintendent of the Year]; and Dr. Samuel King of the Georgia School Boards Association (GSBA).

A presentation entitled "The Power and the Future of Public Education in Georgia" was presented by Mr. Trent North, Superintendent of Douglas County Schools and the 2023 Superintendent of the Year for the state of Georgia.
