Jonesboro HS Band Picked for the 2024 Macy's Thanksgiving Parade®

Majestic Marching Cardinals to participate in the event's 98th edition

JONESBORO - Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) is excited to announce that the Jonesboro High School (JHS) Majestic Marching Cardinals have been selected to perform in the 2024 Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade[®]. The surprise announcement was made during a special assembly in the school's gymnasium. For the JHS band, who will represent the state of Georgia, this will mark their first Parade appearance.

As part of the announcement, the Macy's team presented the Jonesboro High School Majestic Marching Cardinals with a \$10,000 fundraising kick-off. The band will spend the next 18 months planning for their Parade appearance through rehearsals and creative fundraising events that will prepare the participating students for the march of a lifetime.
