JONESBORO – Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) joins with Dr. Shakeria Chaney, principal of North Clayton Middle School (NCMS), in announcing several North Clayton Middle scholars are competing in their first international graphic design challenge through Bright Spark! Bright Spark is part of Bridge Innovate's Innovation for Good programming and is designed to ignite creative confidence in students and educators using design thinking. Bright Spark offers innovation competitions for students in grades fourth through 12th to build design skills such as empathy, creative problem-solving, prototyping, and pitching.

Students who are interested in STEAM and entrepreneurship compete in Bright Spark competitions to expand their design skills and innovation portfolio.
