CCPS Shares Early/Advance Voting Information

E-SPLOST VII is one of the items that will be voted on during the Special Election

JONESBORO - Clayton County Public Schools' (CCPS) encourages all stakeholders to exercise their constitutional right to make their voices heard through the ballot box during the March 21, 2023 Special Election. Included on the ballot is a resolution that would continue the Education-Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (E-SPLOST) for another five year period. Information related to CCPS E-SPLOST VII forecasted initiatives can be found below.

Clayton County Board of Elections has scheduled Early and Advance Voting for the county's registered voters for the March 21, 2023 Special Election Runoff. Early and Advance Voting will begin Monday, February 27, 2023 and will continue through Friday, March 17, 2023.

E-SPLOST VII is not a new tax! Residents of and visitors to Clayton County have been participating in the E-SPLOST since 1997. If approved on Tuesday, March 21, 2023, the sales tax on all consumer goods will remain the same. The E-SPLOST does not have a direct impact on your property taxes.
