CCPS to Close All Schools and Offices on Monday, January 8

CCBOE reschedules meeting to Tuesday, January 9, at 6 p.m.

JONESBORO – In light of recent weather reports and the decisions of bordering school district and schools systems across the Metro Atlanta Area, Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) will close, Monday, January 8, 2018, until further notice. This decision extends to all programs and activities.

“This decision is made in the interest of keeping our students safe during the anticipated adverse weather conditions,” said Dr. Morcease J. Beasley, CCPS Superintendent of Schools. “We anticipate resuming a regular schedule on Tuesday, January 9. We will continue to monitor weather conditions and will issue advisories as necessary.”

“We also encourage our parents/guardians to monitor the official reporting stations of CCPS, WSB-TV (Channel 2) and 95.5 FM and 750 AM WSB Radio,” he added.
