- Determine early dismissal days for 2018-19 school year – create a survey to all school administrators
- Professional Development to share TSS changes with all teachers (Rigor & Relevance Training Work)
- Establish a budget survey – what should Superintendent consider and/or discontinue as budgetary items
- Superintendent shared 3 Areas of Inequality to address within the school system:
1 – Inequality of Quality (Leadership and Instruction) 2 – Inequality of Access 3 – Inequality of Resources
- Discussion and update on Instruction Site Facilitators (ISF's)
- How are we addressing limited and/or no internet access for children and families in apartment or community complex's
- What is the status of considering a block schedule for CCPS
- How are we addressing the substitutes problem – is there a plan to hire more to cover classes to allot more productive planning time for teachers
- Are we considering more options/resources to support and focus on K-2 verses K-5
- How are we addressing the shorted in mentoring teachers throughout the school district
- Will district leaders consider offering computer training to all teachers; particularly new teachers and ongoing training
