Clayton County Board of Education Adopts Tentative FY2019 Budget

During its May 7, 2018 meeting, the Clayton County Board of Education (CCBOE) adopted the Tentative FY2019 Budget. With the adoption of the Superintendent of Schools Morcease J. Beasley's proposed FY2019 Budget, the CCBOE will conduct two public hearings, scheduled for **Monday, May 14, 2018** and **Monday, May 21, 2018**. The schedule for each night will be as follows:

- 5:30 p.m. FY2019 Proposed Salary Schedule Hearings to receive public input on proposed teacher salaries prior to the Board adopting the FY2019 Budget
- 6:00 p.m. Budget Hearing to receive public input on the budget prior to the Board adopting the FY2019 budget

All hearings will be held in the Board Room of the Administration Complex, 1058 Fifth Avenue in Jonesboro. Immediately following the Budget Hearings, Dr. Beasley will conduct a FY2019 Community Budget Update.
