Clayton County Suspends Outdoor Activities for September 4

JONESBORO - The leadership of Clayton County Public Schools has suspended or cancelled all outdoor activities to include physical education classes, unstructured play activity, and athletic practices for Wednesday, September 4, 2019. This decision has been made based on a review of weather forecasts and local reports which indicate temperatures and humidity levels will create adverse heat related conditions. Students and staff are advised to remain indoors in a cool environment. In terms of scheduled athletic events, all high school softball games and cross country meets have been cancelled. These cancellations also extend to middle school football games.

Additional advisories may be released to stakeholders as conditions warrant.
