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New Morrow High School Breaks Ground



The students and staff of Morrow High will have a new facility in the year 2022. In January of 2020, the Board approved the \$85.7 Million High School and construction has already begun. Located next to Clayton County Public Schools' newest facility, East Clayton Elementary, this facility will serve as the replacement high school for the currently standing 50 year old facility. The architect, Perkins+Will, designed a school unlike any other, with its stunning and unique curves, the over 345,000 square foot building will definitely stand out amongst other high schools not only in Clayton County but the metropolitan area. The three story facility will include 64 classrooms, 16 science labs, a Music Suite, two story fitness center as well as a Competition and Auxiliary gym. The facility will also offer students classes such as Aviation Maintenance, Flight Operations, 2D/3D Art and Pharmacy, just to name a few. The two story media center, student commons and teacher workrooms are placed strategically throughout the school to provide opportunities for both students and staff to collaborate amongst their peers. The exterior of the grand facility will have separate parent and bus drop-off & pickup areas, turfed baseball and softball fields, two practice fields, six tennis courts and lastly the district's 4th stadium will be part of this campus as well featuring a turf field and an eight lane rubber track. The beautiful new Morrow High is being constructed by Meja Construction and will be complete in 2022.

Safety & Security Headquarters

The new Safety and Security Headquarters is now complete and ready for operation. The square foot building which previously operated as a local bank in Jonesboro has been completely converted over the past five months. The space now consists of eleven offices, one large conference room, a kitchenette and rooms for uniforms and the armory. Also, included were the addition of new access control, surveillance and security systems. The dated exterior of the building was refreshed as well with a crisp off white and modern black trim to match the adjacent Tara Stadium. The new Headquarters was designed by CDH Partners and performed by MEJA Construction as part of the \$1.8 Million project in conjunction with the Hines Ward Field upgrades at Tara Stadium.

With the new scoreboard installation, grandstand improvements and turf field modifications complete, the Hines Ward Field at Tara Stadium rebranding project is near completion. The exterior of the ticket booth and concessions have been painted while modifications to the pressbox such as enclosing the space, adding new lighting and HVAC have begun. In addition to this, Tara Stadium will receive a grand entry with a new canopy, fencing and LED signage at the frontage The Hines Ward Field Upgrades was designed by CDH Partners and is being performed by MEJA Construction as part of the \$1.8 Million project in conjunction with the new Safety & Securi-











Jonesboro High

The community of Jonesboro including constituents, students and staff all welcomed the completion of Phase 1A of the Jonesboro High renovation project. Phase I included the Music Suite as well as the competition Gym. The Music Suite includes three separate classrooms for Band, Chorus and Orchestra. Each classroom is equipped with practice rooms, offices and storage rooms. The new gym includes both girls' & boys' Home and Visitor locker rooms, a weight room, training room, new offices for coaches, concessions and the third level hospitality suite, affectionally named the Cardinal's Nest. Connecting the new gym to the existing buildings is a beautiful 29' wide corridor which house the many trophies from the rich history of Jonesboro High. Phase 1B will which includes the cafeteria, kitchen and CTAE spaces will be complete in the Spring of next year. The Jonesboro High renovation will be completed in 2021 and is being performed by MEJA Construction.















Riverdale High

The nearly two year large scale renovation of Riverdale High is nearly at completion. J&R Construction and Development has steadily moved through the CTAE wing with half of the building being complete and occupied by students while wrapping up the last phase in the second half of the building. In the corridors, low voltage, electrical, HVAC and plumbing continues. While in the classrooms, all ceiling grid installation is complete, floors have been prepped for new VCT and door frames & walls have been prepped for painting. The two computer lab addition is near completion with floors and ceiling now installed and awaiting cleaning and furniture. On the exterior, roofing is now complete with installation of the white cap, fencing, sod installation and tree removal have begun. The entire Riverdale High renovation will be complete by this coming Spring at \$20.5 Million.





Mt. Zion Elementary

The students and staff of Mt. Zion Elementary have only two more phases remaining before completion. The new HVAC units and roof are near completion which are following the phasing of the classrooms. Currently MEJA Construction has eight classrooms under renovation. These include new flooring, paint, windows, casework and doors & hardware. The exterior of the building includes two new playgrounds, painting of the EIFs and the installation of a new LED school sign. The \$7 Million Perkins+Will project will be complete in the Spring of 2020.








Brown Elementary

Brown Elementary is currently within its last phase with only a few weeks remaining. The last phase consists of eleven classrooms which include Art, Music and nine standard classrooms. As with previous phases, the scope include new finishes such as paint & flooring, new life safety and security items such as the intercom, fire alarm, camera and access control. An upgrade of windows , doors and lighting have already been installed are include as well. Once complete, the exterior will receive a fresh look with new lettering and painting of the EIFs. The Perkins+Will designed \$6.4 Million renovations are being conducted by J&R Construction Development.
