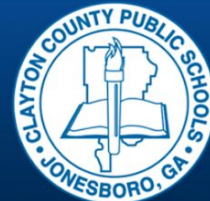

JONESBORO – Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) is proud to offer again **SummerT.I.M.E.** (Thrive, Inspire, Motivate, and Engage); an enrichment opportunity to encourage students to learn beyond the classroom. SummerT.I.M.E. is a series of summer learning experiences designed to allow students the opportunity to participate in positive learning and engage in various fun-filled Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) activities. These experiences will provide students in grades K-11 engaging learning sessions to develop skills employers and colleges are currently looking for in STEM literate individuals such as creativity, critical thinking, collaboration, communication, innovation, and systematic problem-solving. SummerT.I.M.E. Learning Camps are free and will be located at various school sites throughout the district.

Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) is continuing to monitor national and local reports regarding the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). As a precaution, CCPS has suspended all summer learning programs that were scheduled for the month of June 2020. The district is reviewing contingency plans to support its STEM Camps and Advanced Learning for All Programs.
