As part of the district's summer reading program, students in grades Kindergarten through Grade 8 have access to eRead Kids available online (tinyurl.com/ereadkids) and/or on mobile devices by downloading the free *Axis* 360 app on Apple iOS, Android and Kindle devices. *Axis* 360 is an electronic book service that provides access to popular eBooks and audiobooks. Students entering Grades 9 through 12 have access to the *Open eBooks* app. Designed to make browsing, accessing, and reading eBooks simple, *Open eBooks* uses next generation technology to make reading on smartphones and tablets simple and convenient. This app is available for Apple iOS and Android devices. **Important:** It is asked that parents/guardians and/or students email the student's name and school name to claytonreads@clayton.k12.ga.us to receive an access code to these eBook libraries.
