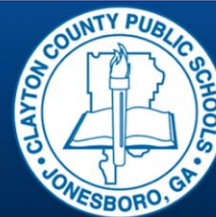

## **Board of Education to Hold Virtual Meetings May 26 & June 1**

*Both the Work Session and Regular Meeting are set to begin at 6 p.m.*

**JONESBORO** – While Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) remains closed due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the district’s leadership is focused on maintaining an effective organization that will be ready when a regular schedule for school returns. To that end, the Clayton County Board of Education will conduct a **Work Session** on Tuesday, May 26, 2020 and a regular **Board Meeting** on Monday, June 1, 2020. Both meetings are scheduled to begin at 6:00 p.m. As with the May 4 session, these meetings will be held virtually using **video-conferencing** technology.
