SummerT.I.M.E. is a series of summer learning experiences designed to allow students the opportunity to participate in positive learning and engage in various fun-filled Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) activities. These experiences will provide students in grades K-11 engaging learning sessions to develop skills employers and colleges are currently looking for in STEM literate individuals such as creativity, critical thinking, collaboration, communication, innovation, and systematic problem-solving.
