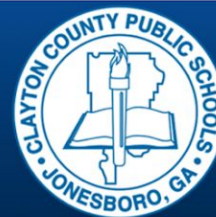

- **Wednesday, June 10, 2020 – 6:00 p.m.** -- Budget Hearing to receive public input prior to the Board of Education adoption of the FY2021 Budget
- **Wednesday, June 17, 2020 – 6:00 p.m.** -- Budget Hearing to receive public input prior to the Board of Education adoption of the FY2021 Budget

Public hearings will be virtual based upon the Governor's Orders using **video-conferencing** technology.
