Meal Service Operations for the Week of January 18, 2020

The school Nutrition Department of Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) has released the following information for meal service operations for the Martin Luther King birthday week:

- ➤ CCPS will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2021, in honor of the MLK, Jr. Holiday. As such there will be no meal service on Monday, January 18.
- ➤ Children will receive two separate meals on Friday, January 15th. One meal will be for Friday, January 15th and the second meal will be for Monday, January 18, 2021.
- > Due to the holiday falling on Monday, January 18th, meals will be delivered into communities on Tuesday, January 19, 2021, from 8:30 11:00 am
- ➤ Regular meal service will resume on Wednesday, January 20, 2021. Children can expect to receive their Wednesday and Thursday meals on this day.

It should be noted that meal service delivery days will periodically be adjusted when a holiday falls on a Monday or any day during a scheduled school week.
