Public Hearings on Millage Rate to be Virtual

JONESBORO - Due to concerns over a possible positive COVID contact, the Clayton County Board of Education (CCBOE) has reset the first two public hearings on the 2021 millage rate to a **virtual setting**. The hearings on the proposed tax increase will take place on **Monday, August 9, at 11:00 a.m. and 6 p.m.** The agenda for the public hearings is attached.

The CCBOE announces its tentative intention to maintain the current millage rate at 20 mills to provide revenue support for the Clayton County Public Schools FY2022 Budget. All interested citizens are invited to offer comment by registering at the following link:
