NFL GREAT INTRODUCTIONS



Morgan Burnett graduated from North Clayton High School and went on to play college football at Georgia Tech. The Green Bay Packers selected Burnett in the third round and he became a Super Bowl Champion with the Packers in 2010. After eight seasons with the Green Bay Packers, Burnett went on to play one season for the Pittsburgh Steelers and one season for the Cleveland Browns before retiring in 2021.



D.J. Shockley graduated from North Clayton High School and went on to play college football at the University of Georgia. The Atlanta Falcons selected Shockley in the 2006 NFL draft. Shockley left the Falcons in 2010. Currently, Shockley works as a Sports Anchor for Atlanta Affiliate FOX5 news.



Kyle Love graduated from North Clayton High School and went on to play college football at Mississippi State University. The New England Patriots signed Love to play for the Patriots in 2010. Love continued to play for the Patriots until 2013. After 2013, Love was signed by the Jacksonville Jaguars and then by the Kansas City Chiefs. The Carolina Panthers signed Love in 2014 and he continued to play with the Panthers until 2019. In 2020, Love signed with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. Love announced his retirement in 2021.



Cordy Glenn graduated from Riverdale High School and went on to play college football at the University of Georgia. The Buffalo Bills selected Glenn to play for the Bills in 2012. Glenn would play for the Bills until 2018 when he was traded to the Cincinnati Bengals. Glen last played for the Bills in 2020. After the NFL, Mr. Glenn continues to serve others as evidenced by his recent launch of the Cordy Glenn Foundation Scholarship that supports student-athletes at his alma mater, Riverdale High School.



Tashard Choice graduated from Lovejoy High School and went on to play college football at Georgia Tech. The Dallas Cowboys selected Choice to play for the Cowboys in 2008. He continued to play for the Cowboys until 2011 when he was claimed off of waivers by Washington. Choice also played for the Buffalo Bills in 2011 and 2012. He then played for the Indianapolis Colts until his release in 2014. In 2016, Choice joined the coaching staff of the Cowboys; he currently is the running backs coach for the University of Texas.



Cameron Sutton graduated from Jonesboro High School and went on to play college football at the University of Tennessee. The Pittsburgh Steelers selected Sutton to play for the Steelers in 2017. Sutton continues to play for the Steelers where he contributes to the team's success as a cornerback. In 2021, Sutton signed a two-year contract to continue in his role as a cornerback for the Steelers.



Harry Douglas graduated from Jonesboro High School and went on to play college football at Louisville. The Atlanta Falcons drafted Douglas in 2008. He continued to play for the Falcons until 2015 at which time he signed a three-year deal with the Tennessee Titans and continued to play with the Titans until 2017.



Hines Ward graduated from Forest Park High School and went on to play college football at the University of Georgia. The Pittsburgh Steelers selected Ward to play for the Steelers in 1998. As a Steeler, Ward was a Super Bowl Champion in Super Bowl XL and XLIII. In addition, Ward was named MVP of Super Bowl XL. Ward was voted to four consecutive Pro Bowls from 2001-2004. Ward announced his retirement in 2012. After his retirement, Ward created his Hines Ward Helping Hands Foundation which continues to advocate for children of mixed-race.

NFL GREAT INTRODUCTIONS



Preston Williams graduated from Lovejoy High School and went on to play college football at the University of Tennessee and Colorado State University. Williams signed with the Miami Dolphins as an undefeated free agent in 2019. As of 2022, Williams continues to play wide receiver for the Dolphins.




Kindle Vildor graduated from North Clayton High School and went on to play college football at Georgia Southern. Vildor was selected by the Chicago Bears in the 2020 NFL draft.



Chris Scott graduated from Lovejoy High School and went on to play college football at the University of Tennessee. Scott was drafted by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the 2010 NFL draft. In 2012, Scott signed with the Green Bay Packers and later that year signed with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. He then signed with the Carolina Panthers in 2013 and then later signed with the New York Giants in 2018.



Andre Hastings graduated from Morrow High School and went on to play college football at the University of Georgia. He was selected by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the 1993 NFL draft. Hastings played 8 seasons with the Steelers, New Orleans Saints, and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. Hastings performance in Super Bowl XXX is of particular significance; as he caught 10 passes for 98 yards and returned 2 punts for 18 yards playing for the Steelers.



Rodney Smith graduated from Mundy's Mill High School and went on to play college football at the University of Minnesota. Smith signed as an undrafted free agent with the Carolina Panthers in 2020. Smith signed with the Tennessee Titans in 2021 and later signed with the Detroit Lions in 2021.



Antwione Williams graduated from Lovejoy High School and played college football at Georgia Southern. Williams was drafted by the Detroit Lions in 2016. He then spent time with the Minnesota Vikings, Seattle Seahawks, and Carolina Panthers from 2017-2019.



Joe Burns attended Morrow Middle School and went on to play college football at Georgia Tech, where he was an all-conference running back. After college, Burns entered the NFL in 2002 as a member of the Buffalo Bills organization. He continued to play for the Bills until 2006.



Scott Woerner graduated from Jonesboro High School and went on to play college football at the University of Georgia. Woerner was drafted by the Atlanta Falcons in the 1981 NFL draft. He played for the Falcons during the 1981 season; later playing for the Philadelphia Stars of the USFL. In 1987, Woerner signed with the New Orleans Saints.


