Heat Index Alert - an Orange Level has been Established for August 29

Current Heat Index is projected to peak at 95 degrees around 2:00 p.m.

JONESBORO - Based on information from the National Weather Service (NWS) for Tuesday, August 29, 2023, the heat index for Jonesboro and Clayton County is projected to reach 95 degrees around 2 p.m. and will decline below 87 degrees until after 6:00 p.m. There is also a high chance of heavy rains after 3:00 p.m. This inclement weather may affect temperatures.

As a result, the district has established an **Orange Level** for the heat index for the period between 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. It is recommended that limited outdoor activities are allowed including scheduled athletic events and practices. These should be monitored carefully with frequent water breaks and breaks from physical activity. Scheduled games will remain, with the determination to play being made by the Georgia High School Association (GHSA) officials as it pertains to adjusted starting times.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to take this information into consideration when planning any activities after school. Parents/guardians are also encouraged to make sure their children are dressed in appropriate clothing and have access to water so they are properly hydrated.

Special Note: The information expressed here is the most current information related to anticipated weather in the district. It should be understood that weather changes may occur and as those changes are confirmed from the National Weather Service, they will be reported for any actions deemed appropriate.
